**Response to Proposed USPS Rate Increase**

*February 6, 2007*

As you know, Brokers Worldwide forwarded a response to the USPS regarding the December 20, 2006, *Federal Register* Proposed Rule titled, "International Product and Pricing Initiatives". As indicated in the *Federal Register*, the USPS has proposed significant international mail pricing changes, which are scheduled to take effect in May, 2007. We understand a number of our customers have also forwarded their own responses to the USPS, and we would like to thank you for this combined effort. In fact, in the January 17, 2007 version of the USPS' *Federal Register*, the USPS extended the comment period from January 19<sup>th</sup> to January 31<sup>st</sup>, as a result of the degree of public response they had received.

Brokers Worldwide has received a letter from the USPS thanking us for our feedback. The next step will be for the USPS to evaluate the comments they have received, giving them full consideration before the final rule is published. Brokers Worldwide will keep our customers posted regarding any additional updates concerning the USPS postage increase.
