Update on Delivery Disruptions in Australia & Egypt

February 16, 2011

Brokers Worldwide has received the following updates from the USPS regarding the mail disruptions in Australia and Egypt:

Australia

Australia Post has reported that mail is now getting through to most residents and businesses in Cyclone Yasi affected communities. Mail is reportedly being delivered to accessible areas where it is safe to do so; otherwise mail is being held at the local post office. All of Australia Post's corporate post offices are now fully operational, and staff have been working tirelessly to restore postal services to the affected areas.

Egypt

The USPS received an update indicating that mail services in Egypt have partially resumed. We are waiting on word from the USPS regarding when they will begin releasing mail to the country. Brokers Worldwide will forward this information as soon as it becomes available.
