USPS Rate Case: PRC Opinion & Recommendation (Domestic Services & Rates)

March 1, 2007

Brokers Worldwide has received notification of the status of the R2006-1 Omnibus Rate Case, filed by the USPS on May 3, 2006, to adjust postage prices to cover operational costs and respond to changes in the marketplace. The Postal Regulatory Commission issued its Opinion and Recommended Decision on Monday, February 26, 2007. The next step is for the Governors to review the PRC's recommendation. If approved, the Board of Governors will set the implementation date for the new prices.

The recommendation above is in regards to the USPS' domestic services and rates. International rates, which are determined separately from domestic prices, will be adjusted to coincide with the domestic rate changes.
