USPS Rate Increase Scheduled for May 11th ***April 10, 2009***

As previously communicated, the United States Postal Service has announced that prices for mailing services will increase effective Monday, May 11, 2009. Some of the services affected by this increase include Bound Printed Matter, Standard Mail, Media Mail, Flats, Letters and First Class mail, as well as international competitive products, such as International Priority Airmail (IPA) and International Surface Airlift (ISAL). As a result of the USPS postage increases, it will be necessary for Brokers Worldwide to adjust our rates for these services.

Brokers Worldwide's Account Managers are currently in the process of evaluating the effect of the postage increase on each of our customers and communicating any rate changes. We fully understand the challenges faced by each of our customers in the current mail market, and we are committed to doing everything possible to minimize this increase. As you review the base rate changes announced by the USPS, you will recognize our commitment to reducing the impact of the postage increase on our customers.
