#### **Canada Post Strike Possible as Early as June 2<sup>nd</sup>**

*May 31, 2011*

At the conclusion of yesterday's meeting between The Canadian Union of Postal Workers (CUPW) and Canada Post, the CUPW's bargaining team provided 72 hours notice of their right to strike. This means that a strike can take place as early as Thursday, June 2nd. With the notice now served, the CUPW can choose to move forward on Thursday with either a national disruption, rotating disruptions, or no disruption. The CUPW, which represents roughly 50,000 workers, says that it has presented the Canada Post with its "final offer".

However, delivery throughout Canada will be on hold until the strike is resolved.
