Canada Post Rotating Strikes Hit Montreal

June 6, 2011

Rotating strikes by the Canadian Union of Postal Workers (CUPW) have ended in Winnipeg and Hamilton and a 24-hour strike began yesterday at 23:30 in Montreal. The USPS ISCs are holding Montreal dispatches for the 24-hour period, and it is expected that service for these dispatches will be impacted by 1-2 days. The USPS has indicated that it will continue to accept, process and deliver mail to Canada until further notice.
