Spanish Post Affected by Transport Strike

The Spanish Post has reported that the Association of Transport and Logistics Companies "Plataforma para la Defensa del Transporte" began a national road transport strike on Friday, June 6th, to continue for an indefinite period. Trade unions Fenadismar and Confedetras have also announced a road transport strike which began today, Monday, June 9th. If it continues, reports estimate that the country-wide strike could paralyze food and fuel deliveries by Thursday. In addition, both inbound and outbound mail are expected to be delayed during the strikes, which are anticipated to last up to five days.
