Canada Post Suspends Operations Countrywide

June 15, 2011

As a result of the rotating strikes and accelerating decline in volume combined with the inability to delivery mail on a timely and safe basis, Canada Post suspended its operations and delivery of all mail across the country beginning last night. During the suspension, Canada Post will not be delivering Letter Post, Parcels and EMS. Inbound international mail will not be accepted starting on Wednesday, June 15th. Canada Post has plans in place to secure all mail that is left in the system during the lockout, and to resume normal operations quickly once the current situation is resolved.

Brokers Worldwide will continue to accept and process Canada-bound mail and will hold the mail securely until the situation in Canada is resolved. Brokers Worldwide continues to work closely with the USPS to monitor this situation, and will provide our customers with updates as they become available.
