Canada Post Operations Resume Tonight

June 27, 2011

The Back-To-Work Legislation introduced last Monday by the Canadian Government was passed last night. As a result, Canada Post employees will start back to work as of tonight at 8:30 p.m. Mail will start to be delivered within Canada on Tuesday, June 28th. All mailboxes will be unsealed starting today and post offices that were closed will reopen on Tuesday and resume regular operations.

Due the volume of mail being held by other countries and within the Canada Post system during the dispute, transit times may still be delayed until the backlog is cleared. Canada Post has indicated that they will move as quickly as possible to process and deliver the mail. Any mail that was in the system at the time the lockout occurred has been secured for processing and delivery. The USPS has informed us that they will begin accepting mail for Canada first thing Tuesday morning. Mail that was already being held in the USPS' network is now being released and transported into Canada.

Brokers Worldwide continues to work closely with the USPS to monitor this situation and will provide our customers with updates as they become available.
