**Israel Postal Company Postpones Scheduled Strike, But Sanctions Continue**

*June 28, 2007*

The Israel Postal Company workers union has made a last minute decision to postpone a general strike planned for this morning after the government chose to delay the July 1 new rate schedule for bulk mailings; however, sanctions will continue, resulting in slow mail delivery and the early closing of post offices at 3:00pm. Brokers Worldwide will continue to collect Israel-bound mail from our customers. Although the mail will reach Israel in the same amount of time as before, mail services within the country may be delayed as a result of the sanctions.
