Royal Mail: New Strikes Announced

September 21, 2007

According to the Royal Mail, the Communication Workers Union (“CWU”) has announced further strike action to take place in the form of two 48-hour strikes on October 5th - 6th, and October 8th - 9th.

In addition to the two 48-hour strikes, the CWU has announced that they will also start a rolling program of strikes beginning on October 15th and continuing weekly until the dispute is resolved.

The Royal Mail has indicated that they have “well-developed contingency plans in order to reduce the effect of the strike, but disruption is inevitable”.
