Postal Strike Continues in Brazil

September 21, 2011

A postal strike which officially began last Wednesday, September 14th, continues today across the country with reportedly no sign of compromise over a new labor deal. According to Brazilian media, the strike has already delayed the delivery of 2.5 million letters, telegrams and parcels. Roughly one third of the postal work force is participating in the strike, with union members holding demonstrations across the country, including in front of the Ministry of Communications. FENTECT, the National Federation of Postal Workers, said yesterday that strike action is occurring in all 26 of Brazil's states and the Federal District, including 34 local unions with one remaining union expected to join the strike Wednesday.

Brokers Worldwide will continue to accept, process and deliver mail to Brazil until further notice; however, delivery delays can be expected as a result of the limited workforce due to the strike.
