USPS Update on Australia and Oceania Region

November 17, 2010

Brokers Worldwide received the following update from the USPS regarding the issues in the Australia and Oceania regions.

The environmental impact of the equinox winds continues to cause USPS's airline partners challenges in moving mail, passengers and cargo into the Oceania region. Nevertheless, we are working with our airline partners to continue to provide support out of all ISCs as possible. We have secured additional lift on a weekly basis via chartered aircraft to support movement of mail into the region, but the pace of movement has slowed due to the precautions needed to ensure safety for the airline crews. We expect to secure additional capacity in the next few weeks as Qantas is taking actions to secure new Rolls Royce engines to power their currently grounded A-380s. We are leaving no stone unturned to accomplish our mission.

We will provide additional details as they become available to us.
