USPS Announces 2012 Prices for International Competitive Products

December 5, 2011

The United States Postal Service (USPS) has announced new prices for their international competitive products which are scheduled to be effective on January 22, 2012. A summary of some of the overall average percent increases by service follows:

- Express Mail International® (EMI): 11.6 percent
- Priority Mail International® (PMI): 8.7 percent
- International Priority Airmail™ (IPA®): 1.0 percent
- International Surface Air Lift® (ISAL®): 13.7 percent
